The Pinnacles Desert is located 200km north of Perth (two hours by car) and can be enjoyed as a day trip or stay the night at nearby Cervantes. These amazing natural limestone structures in the Nambung National Park were formed over 25,000 years ago, after the sea receded and left deposits of sea shells. Over time, coastal winds removed the surrounding sand, leaving the pillars exposed to the elements. Drop into the Pinnacles Desert Discovery Centre at the edge of the Pinnacles Desert for displays videos and objects that explain the geology of the pinnacles formations and the cultural heritage or contact the Pinnacles Visitor Centre below.
